Soon, the Poydras Home campus will feature two new buildings with three homes each, in which residents will have even more personalized care and interaction while experiencing the same personal freedoms they already know. Homes will feature open floor plans with spacious living rooms including comfortable seating and fireplaces, dining rooms and state-of-the-art kitchens where residents can participate in meal preparation if they wish, private bathrooms, and increased access to our beautiful grounds via balconies and patios. Poydras Home's Historic House will be rebuilt as the Center for Healthy Living, where residents will enjoy a yoga studio, therapy gym, library, meditative space, expanded salon and spa, and a multipurpose space for additional programming and education.

BENEFITS

One of the many benefits of our expanded care approach (based on The Green House Project model), is that a smaller number of residents share each house and each house has a dedicated Care Partner who knows not only each senior's health needs and concerns but is highly trained to assist with all manner of tasks, helping to make each day meaningful and bright. This close-knit, smaller community setup within the larger community has resulted in less COVID exposure and infection in The Green House Project facilities across the nation.
