In tandem with the announcement of the exciting Poydras Home Reimagined project, Poydras Home's new website went live during the first quarter of 2021, introducing the Green House care model and all of its strengths. We also launched our multiyear Poydras Home Reimagined Giving Campaign offering multiple ways to support this important project through 40+ exterior and interior naming opportunities.

## Poydras Home Reimagined Expansion.

With the completion of the Poydras Home Reimagined expansion in late 2022, we will become Louisiana's first community to offer the revolutionary approach known as The Green House model of care. This care model transitions away from the institutional feel of nursing facilities and introduces small group family-style homes.

Overseen by architecture firm Eskew Dumez Ripple (EDR), Poydras Home Reimagined broke ground in 2021. Linked by a glass atrium that serves as an entryway, two new buildings will accommodate six separate homes. These open floor plans encompass spacious living rooms, comfortable seating, fireplaces, dining rooms, stateof-the-art kitchens, private bedrooms with en suite bathrooms, and balconies and patios with beautiful garden views. Additionally, each home has a small team of dedicated Care Partners, highly skilled in all types of assistance.

## Partnerships and Community Outreach

While adjusting to the evolving challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic, Poydras Home has been fortunate to continue our many national and local community partnerships. Our Soul Strings (LPO), Artful Minds (NOMA) and University intergenerational groups shifted to ZOOM. Tulane and Loyola Service Learning students devised a creative solution to pandemic restrictions by launching a "Friendship Line" to keep connecting safely with Poydras Home residents. The students held real-time virtual conversations with residents beginning in 2020 and also recorded guided meditations, music therapy, and group exercise programs.

In 2021 we established a partnership with Zeus' Rescues, a local animal rescue organization, to launch our Man's Best Friend program. Made possible by a generous grant from the I'm Still Here Foundation, Man's Best Friend pairs Assisted Living memory care residents with regular visits from shelter dogs awaiting adoption to their forever home. Spending time with animals generates a greater sense of well being for our residents and the dogs benefit from the attention too!








### HOLIDAY TREE LIGHTING THRILLS VIRTUALLY AND IN PERSON
